Performances typically seen at Christkindlmarkets throughout the world include (but are not limited to): carolers, yodelers, accordionist, acapella groups, blacksmith demonstration, wood carving, etc.

## **How Are Performers Selected?**

DMEHA reserves the right to approve, refuse, and limit performances at Christkindlmarket Des Moines. While exclusivity does not exist, a limited number of performers will be approved to perform. Applicants are reviewed based on the performance they would like to present at Christkindlmarket Des Moines. Performers are not allowed to add or change their performance after the application process is complete or at all during the event.

All performers are required to submit an application. Performers are not selected on a first-come, first-served basis, but on the basis of what Christkindlmarket Des Moines needs to produce a community event keeping in line with its mission. Each performer will be reviewed based on several criteria, including quality, uniqueness, European cultural heritage connection, added value, and other pertinent criteria. Christkindlmarket Des Moines is committed to choosing a performance mix that is attractive to our community while keeping the balance of the event intact.

## Describe the performance space
